VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE HEALTHROOM

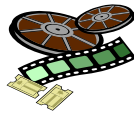
Attention Parents/Guardians of Students who have medication in school

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

As the school year comes to a close and our thoughts turn to vacations and summer camps, we would like everyone to keep in mind some important information for September.

- NFCS will again be purchasing many school supplies and the homework assignment books in bulk for all the students. A small fee per student will be due in September for these supplies.
- A large informational mailing will be sent to you by the end of July which will outline everything you need to know or do before school starts in September. There will be many papers in it which you must fill out and return to school *before* the first day of school..
- The dates for you to bring these completed important forms back to school will be listed on the first page of the mailing. If the papers are not returned to school prior to the first day of school in September, your child/ren will not be allowed to start school in the fall.
- Please take some time this summer to send away for your Child Abuse and Criminal Background Clearances if you haven't already done so. Once school starts in September, you will not be able to volunteer anywhere around our students unless these clearances are received by the school.
- Don't forget that you can put in some of your required volunteer hours (20 hours per year per child) during the summer months. The office is open throughout the summer and there is an abundance of work to do to prepare for the new school year.
