In order for me to be able to provide medication and care for your child, it is requested that this form is returned to the nurse no later than *Tuesday, September 29, 2009. Please complete all the information on both sides of the paper.* **PLEASE NOTE: IT**

IS OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE THAT YOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT PERSON BE AVAILABLE TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD ON SHORT NOTICE. With the **POTENTIAL** of an increased

number of children experiencing flu like symptoms, it is critical to get these children home as soon as possible to prevent the spread of illness.

The Approved Medications list has been reviewed and approved by Dr. Eniko Kovats, who is our school physician. These medications are available in my office and are for occasional minor discomforts and to avoid early dismissal from school. If your child requires any prescription or non-prescription medicine on a regular basis, there is a form to be completed by your doctor and the medication needs to be brought to school in its proper packaging by an adult.
