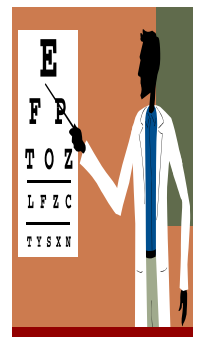

HOW IT WORKS

You call the school's number and enter the 4 digit extension (listed below) for the mailbox of the person you are calling. You can enter this 4 digit number at anytime during the welcome remarks. You will be connected to your party's voice mail where you can leave a message. All faculty and staff will check their voice mail at least once every day. They will return your call as soon as possible. If you have an urgent or emergency message for anyone you can call the office and your message will be relayed right away.
