

Dear NFCHS Parents and Students,

As we start this year, we would ask for your cooperation in order to ensure safety and orderliness. Please adhere closely to the following procedures for morning and afternoon drop-off and pick-up.

**In the Morning: (Arrival)**

1. Travel east on Rhawn Street
2. Turn Right onto Tulip Street
3. Turn Right onto Decatur Street
4. Please make a right into the school parking lot.
5. Then proceed to follow cones toward the Glass Tower drop-off point
6. Proceed to exit at the gate on Rhawn Street – **DO NOT TURN LEFT OUT OF THE LOT**

*Please note; it is imperative that once your child has been dropped-off that you keep moving in order to maintain order and safety.*

**In the Afternoon: (dismissal)**

1. When picking up, all **cars must remain parked outside of the schoolyard.**
2. Students will proceed outside of the schoolyard to meet parents on Decatur Street.

-----**High School Uniform Reminder**-----

Students are to return to school on these days in full uniform and be clean and neat at all times. Students out of uniform will not be permitted to attend class until the correct piece is delivered to the school. **Furthermore, students must turn off all smart devices (cell phones or ther handheld electronics) upon arrival and leave them securely in their lockers until dismissal.** Failure to adhere to these policies will result in the phone being confiscated and held by an administrator until a parent or guardian retrieves it. **These policies are strictly enforced.**
